

4-TOWN BONSPIEL INFORMATION 2025-2026

FORMAT

- Two teams from each of the four clubs from Bobcaygeon, Fenelon Falls, Haliburton and Minden
- Players to be of age of majority
- Two eight end games (must complete all 8 ends unless there is severe weather forecasted later in the day/evening and the convenor decides to shorten the bonspiel to 6 ends)
- 90-minute timer (at discretion of each club convenor to enforce)
 - Last rock of 6th end must be thrown before time expires
 - If time expires, teams on that sheet only throw 4 rocks per team for the 8th end, 1 rock per player (2 rock free guard)
- Free Guard zone rule applies (5 rocks)
- Avoid teams from same club competing against each other if possible
- Two weeks prior to bonspiel, coordinators should email names of skips to host club convenor

SCORING

- 10 points for a win
- 1 point for each end won, ½ point for a blank end
- ¼ point for each rock scored to a maximum of 3 points

GAME TIE BREAKERS

- If a game is tied after 8 ends, an extra end will be played towards the glass with each player throwing 1 rock.
- Sweeping is allowed a 2-rock free guard zone rule
- If end is blanked, each team will throw 1 rock and closest to the button will win (with sweeping only from teammates)
- The winner of the extra end receives the 10 points for the win but no points are given to either team for the extra end.

ENTRY FEES ARE \$160 PER TEAM AND PRIZES WILL BE:

1st	\$160
2nd	\$100
3rd	\$80

- 50/50 draw - \$5 per ticket, \$20 for 5 tickets

TIE BREAKERS FOR PRIZES

- If there is a tied score(s) at the end of the bonspiel, ties will be broken in the following order:
 1. Total ends won in both games. If still tied, go to
 2. Total rocks scored in both games. If still tied, go to
 3. Lowest total rocks scored against in both games. If still tied, flip a coin.
